Fresh Pear Bread

INGREDIENTS

- 3 large eggs, room temperature
- ♦ 1-1/2 cups sugar
- ♦ 3/4 cup vegetable oil
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ♦ 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 4 cups finely chopped, peeled ripe pears (about 4 medium)
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 1 cup chopped walnuts

IRECTIONS

- **1.** In a bowl, combine the eggs, sugar, oil and vanilla; mix well.
- **2.** Combine flour, baking powder, cinnamon, baking soda and salt; stir into the egg mixture just until moistened.
- **3.** Toss pears with lemon juice, stir pears and walnuts into batter (batter will be thick).
- 4. Spoon into 2 greased 9x5-in. loaf pans.
- **5.** Bake at 350 degrees for 55-60 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean.
- **6.** Cool for 10 minutes before removing loaves from pans to wire racks.

Apples or Asian pears would be a terrific substitute for the pears in this recipe, berries and stone fruits (like plums and peaches) would be too soft and yield too much juice. You can also freeze pear bread up to three months.

Prep Time: 15 mins. Bake Time: 55 mins. + cooling Makes: 2 loaves (16 slices each) C&B 2.0 donated 30 boxes of clothing to the Red Bird Mission and the shoeboxes collected at the church were delivered to the conference center who will give them to the Red Bird Mission.
