



Dear Church Family,

Grace and peace to you from God, our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ!

Seventeen years ago, Mary and I embarked on the journey of a lifetime. Not only did we get married, but we also took our honeymoon to Cape Cod, Massachusetts. One evening as the sun was setting, we were walking in the surf along Craigsville Beach. The tide was coming in and going out, and you could feel the water sucking the sand from beneath your feet. I was wearing shorts, a t-shirt, and a pair of brand-new prescription sunglasses. In a single moment, a rogue wave came up and knocked both of us into the ocean. Mary and I both got up drenched in the cold water of the Atlantic. My brand-new sunglasses were nowhere to be found. They were lost in the Atlantic forever.

It has been just about eight weeks since my father passed. I think about him every day. Last night as we were unpacking a box from our move last year I found a bright orange "Trans-Am" hat. It was a birthday gift from my father back in 1983. I began to cry. I mean it's a hat, right? What I began to realize is that grief is like an ocean wave. You never know where or when it is going to strike, but when it does, there is nothing you can do, but roll with it. Even if you try to hold it in, it will eventually come out and not always in the most positive way. My father would always say, "What could possibly go wrong?" In my estimation, a million little things in my father's body must have gone wrong for him to have died that Monday morning. I don't know and perhaps I never will. The important thing is that my fathers' heart was prepared to be with the Lord. God loved my father. God knew his heart, and God was with him when he crossed the Jordan river from this life to the next.

All of us have the opportunity to know God. God is always with us, whispering to our hearts, and waiting for us to respond. The only question is, will we respond to God, or will we ignore the call upon our lives. Sometimes I think it is easier to wait for a loud booming voice to speak to us as opposed to listening to the still small voice of our heart. We know right from wrong. We know what we are supposed to do; so why don't we do it? Over the summer, some things have taken place in the life of the church. Forty-five cases of water were delivered to the mission IN MY FATHERS KITCHEN. This is a ministry to people in need of all walks of life. Whether they are homeless or not, people can find the grace of Jesus Christ through food, water, and fellowship. This ministry also helps put homeless people to work through a unique program with Onondaga County and the city of Syracuse.

We have begun collecting school supplies for the post-refugees. These groups represent the Karenni, Sudanese, and Nepali. They are continuing to grow and need our continued support. I want to thank you for doing the right thing and being a part of blessing others. My father did that often. He wasn't wealthy, but he gave his heart away in a way that shares the love of Jesus. He welcomed into his home all the stray kids that my brothers and sister brought into the house. He fed them, clothed them in some cases, and gave them a place to stay. I am so proud of my dad; he has been my inspiration.

The Sunday before my father passed, I showed a video in church. There was a line from that video that has stuck with me. "Live your life in such a way that when you die the world cries while you rejoice." I have indeed been crying because I know the impact that my father had on this world and on me. Thank you, Dad, I love you always.

Give your heart to Jesus and leave a legacy of hope. This world desperately needs it. You too can be a miracle to someone you know or perhaps someone you don't. The choice is yours. Choose life. Choose God!

I pray the Lord's blessing on you this day, May God grant you the assurance of God's grace and peace as you serve God faithfully. Be blessed this day in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit!






#### Do you want to sing or play an instrument?

#### Easy Chicken Pot Pie Recipe From Campbell's Kitchen

#### INGREDIENTS

1 can (10 1/2 ounces) Campbell's Condensed Cream of Chicken Soup or Campbell's Condensed 98% Fat Free Cream or Chicken Soup

1 cup reduced fat (2%) milk

1 package (12 ounces) frozen mixed vegetables (carrots, green beans, peas, corn) thawed (about 2 1/4 cups)

1 egg 1 cup of biscuit baking mix

#### DIRECTIONS

Step 1. Heat the oven to 400°F. Stir the soup, 1/2 cup milk, vege-tables and chicken in a 9-inch pie plate or ovenproof skillet.
Step 2. Stir the remaining 1/2 cup milk, egg and baking mix in a small bowl. Spread the batter over the chicken mixture (the batter is thin but will bake up into a perfect crust)

Step 3. Bake for 20 minutes or until the topping is golden brown

Prep time: 10 mins Total time: 30 mins

Serves: 4 people

#### Spiced Hot Apple Cider

#### From: Sara Mertz

- 8 cups fresh apple cider or apple juice
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon or 2 cinnamon sticks
- 1/8 teaspoon grated nutmeg
- 4 whole cloves
- 1 orange, cut into slices
- 8 cinnamon sticks and 1 cup of sweetened whipped cream to top (if desired)

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Heat the cider, cinnamon, nutmeg, cloves and orange slices in a 3-quart saucepan.
- 2. Cook over medium heat for 5 minutes or until the mixture is hot, stirring occasionally.
- 3. Strain the cider into a heatproof pitcher or individual mugs.
- 4. Garnish with cinnamon sticks and whipped cream, if desired.
- 5. Sip and enjoy!
