



Thanksgiving Punch (Fits a 2-gallon drink dispenser)

- 2 gallons apple cider (not spiced)
- 12.2 ounces caramel syrup (1 bottle)
- 1-3 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
- Cinnamon sticks and sliced apples are optional
- ⇒ Serve at room temperature, over ice. Chilled in the refrigerator before hand or warm and served in a crock pot!

Directions:

1. Pour apple cider into a drink dispenser (all but 1/4 of the 2 gallons).

2. Then pour in entire bottle of caramel syrup.

3. Stir in pumpkin spice, using a whisk. Some of the spice may continue to float to the top. Whisk again right before serving. Taste and add more pumpkin spice if desired.

4. Add cinnamon sticks and sliced apples to the punch just before serving if desired. Remember to keep stirring!



Turkey and Stuffing Casserole



<u>Recipe From: Campbell's Kitchen</u>

NGREDIENTS

1 can (10 1/2 ounces) Campbell's Condensed Cream of Mushroom Soup or Campbell's Condensed 98% Fat-Free Cream of Mushroom Soup

1 cup milk or water

1 bag (16 ounces) frozen

vegetable combination

(broccoli, cauliflower, car-

rots), thawed

2 cups cubed cooked Turkey or Chicken

4 cups Pepperidge Farm Herb Seasoned Stuffing

1 cup Swiss cheese or Cheddar cheese (about 4 ounces)

DIRECTIONS

1. Heat the oven to 400°F. Spray a 2-quart casserole dish with vegetable cooking spray.

2. Stir the soup and milk OR water in a large bowl. Add the

vegetables, turkey and stuffing and mix lightly. Spoon the turkey mixture into the casserole.

3. Bake for 20 minutes or until the turkey mixture is hot and

bubbling. Stir the turkey mixture.

4. Top with the cheese.

5. Bake for 5 minutes or until the cheese is melted.

<u>Serving Suggestion</u>: Serve with a salad of mixed greens, dried cranberries and walnuts with a Dijon mustard vinaigrette. For dessert serve sliced pears drizzled with chocolate sauce.

<u>Easy Substitution</u>: Substitute **3 cans** (4.5 ounces **each**) Swanson[®] Premium White Chunk Chicken Breast in Water,

drained, for the cubed cooked turkey.
