Nutella Strawberry Puff Pastry Hearts



Recipe From: A Life Well Consumed Website

INGREDIENTS	DIRECTIONS
1 box frozen puff pastry	1. Preheat oven to 425F.
(Thawed in fridge)	2. Dust flour on surface.
1-2 cups of Nutella	3. Roll out thawed dough to 1/4 inch thickness.
4 tablespoons berry sugar	4. Cut out heart shapes with cookie cutter or freehand.
(for dusting)	5. Mark a border about 1/2 inside, not cutting the pastry right through. You can either do this with cookie
1 pint strawberries (sliced)	cutter or with a knife - it will allow for the edges to puf
5 tablespoon milk	up.
	6. Spread Nutella in the middle with a spoon or offset spatula (you can do this before OR after baking, it's a personal preference).
	7. Brush on milk around the edges, then sprinkle heart-
Prep Time: 25 minutes Cook Time: 20 minutes Total Time: 40 minutes	shapes with sugar. 8. Bake in oven for 15-20 minutes 9. Allow to cool slightly, than place sliced strawberries on top.

Training Description:

Naloxone has been fundamental in the efforts to decrease rates of fatal overdoses. This training teaches first responders, likely opioid overdose witnesses and community members to understand, recognize, respond to and reverse suspected opioid overdoses using naloxone. Participants will learn ways to obtain free or low-cost naloxone for personal use. This training is modeled after the evidence-based SAMHSA Opioid Overdose Prevention Toolkit.

This interactive training is tailored for first responders or other likely witnesses to an opioid overdose.

Boonville Fire Victims

On January 7th, a fire occurred in Boonville, NY. Many residents are still in shock over the fire that has destroyed a row of five wood-framed commercial buildings dating from the 1880s and 1890s. The buildings were home to six businesses, 15 residents and more than a century of memories. Thankfully, there was no injuries or deaths from the fire, but residents are heartbroken that they've lost historic buildings lining the 100 block of Main Street in downtown Boonville. A flood of donations came in, from food, personal items, clothing and volunteer assistance, A GoFundMe page has been set up and surpassed its goal of \$25,000 in one week to help victims. C&B 2.0 heard what happened and came together to assist and help the Boonville fire victims by donating clothing and shoes. A huge thank you goes to those volunteers who took the time to collect and deliver clothing and shoes to help our neighbors in Boonville. We strive to help those in need and during a time of need, we were glad to help! Boonville has made a video pitch to HGTV's "Home Town Makeover" television show in hopes they will get chosen for a extensive renovation, share the hashtag #ChooseBoonville on social media to help get Boonville noticed by HGTV!
