Grandma's Honey Muffins

Recipe From: Taste of Home



INGREDIENTS

- ♦ 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ♦ 1/2 cup sugar
- ♦ 3 teaspoons baking powder
- ♦ 1/2 teaspoon salt
- ♦ 1 large egg, room temperature
- ♦ 1 cup 2% milk
- ♦ 1/4 cup butter, melted
- ♦ 1/4 cup honey

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees.
2. In a large bowl, combine flour, sugar, baking powder and salt.
3. In a small bowl, combine egg, milk, butter and honey. Stir into dry ingredients until moistened.
4. Fill greased or paper-lined muffin cups three fourths full.
5. Bake until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean, 15-18 minutes.
6. Cool for 5 minutes before removing from pan to wire rack.
7. Serve warm and add butter if desired.

Freeze option: Freeze cooled muffins in freezer containers. To use, thaw at room temperature, or if desired, microwave each muffin on high until heated through, 20-30 seconds.

Prep/Total Time: 30 mins.

Makes: 1 dozen
