Please note there will be some changes:

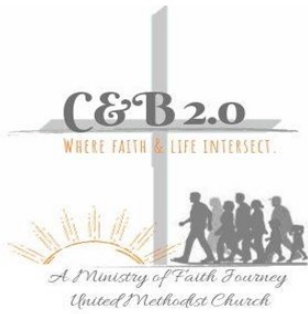
- Face Masks will be required at all times when in the building.

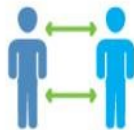

Easy Apple Pie Cinnamon Rolls

INGREDIENTS

- ◆ 1 (12.4 oz) tube refrigerated cinnamon rolls
- ◆ 1 Granny Smith or Golden Delicious apple
- ◆ 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- ◆ 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- ◆ 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ◆ 1/2 teaspoon lime (or lemon juice)

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Dice apple, and mix with cinnamon, brown sugar, vanilla and lime juice until evenly coated.
2. Open cinnamon rolls, and roll each one out until you have a flat disc, set aside icing for later use.
3. Spray a muffin tin with nonstick, then push a cinnamon roll into each cup - make sure to press around the sides so they form their own little cups.
4. Add a generous spoon full of apples to each cinnamon roll cup.
5. Bake at 375 degrees in the oven for 10 minutes.
6. Once done, drizzle with icing that was set aside from the cinnamon rolls.
7. Serve warm and enjoy!
