Dear Friends,

God calls all of us the beloved children of God; let us, therefore, come to God with our love, faith, devotion, and concerns. Peace be with you.

This season of Lent is God's time. The season of faith perfected itself in Jesus Christ, our Lord, and Savior. So many things have happened since Lent started. We have begun our 'Forty Days of Pay it Forward,' and the glory of God has been shown.

We currently have two projects that are underway by our youth. Kiah, my daughter, is heading up the "Cans for Sudan" project. Each week when you bring in your returnable cans Kiah and her mom head to the recycling center. To date, we have returned 1,875 cans for a total of \$93.50 towards supporting our two health care workers in Southern Sudan. We need to average 840 cans a week to meet our goal of \$3,000 for the year. We are well on our way. The cans should be brought into church Monday-Friday 9-12 or on Sunday mornings.

The second project is underway is led by Olivia Osbourn, and she is collecting supplies to make water bottles for those in need. The water bottles will include essentials like socks, snacks, and toiletries that can then be handed out when you see individuals on the road in need. These bottles will be prepared and distributed at the end of March. 'Forty Days of Pay it Forward' was designed to help you think about ways your outward actions can reflect what is happening in your heart. These two fantastic youth are leading the way. Please consider helping them out in their projects.







Lemon Chiffon Cake

"This Lemon Chiffon Cake is light, sweet and topped with creamy lemon buttercream, you could always skip the frosting and dust the cake with powered sugar, a dollop of whipped cream or a glaze ic-



INGREDIENTS

- ◆ 2 cups all purpose flour
- ♦ 3 teaspoons baking powder
- ♦ 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
- ♦ 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- ♦ 7 large eggs, separated
- ♦ 3/4 cup water
- ♦ 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- ♦ 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ◆ 1 1/2 tablespoons lemon zest (3 large lemons)
- ◆ 1/2 teaspoon cream of tartar

Frosting

- ◆ 1/2 cup butter, room temperature
- ♦ 3 cups powdered sugar
- ♦ 1 tablespoon lemon zest
- ◆ 1/4 cups freshly squeezed lemon juice

NIRFATIONS

- **1. Cake:** Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Arrange the oven so you can bake the cake on the lowest rack. Set aside a 10-inch tube pan (Angel Food Cake pan).
- **2.** In the bowl of your stand mixer, sift together the flour, baking powder, sugar, and salt.
- **3.** In a small bowl, whisk together the egg yolks, water, vegetable oil, vanilla, and lemon zest. When combined, add this into the bowl with the flour mixture. Mix on medium-low speed until combined and smooth, scraping the sides of the bowl as necessary.
- **4.** Place the egg whites in a separate large mixing bowl with the cream of tartar. With the whisk attachment or a hand mixer, beat the egg whites on high speed until stiff peaks form.
- **5.** Fold the egg whites into the batter using a rubber spatula until combined. Spoon the batter into the un-greased tube pan.
- **6.** Place the pan on the lowest rack and bake for 50 minutes or until golden and set. Cake will spring back when pressed lightly.
- **7.** When the cake is done, immediately invert the pan, allow the cake to cool for at least an hour.
- **8. Frosting:** In the bowl of your stand mixer or a new bowl, mix together the butter, powdered sugar, lemon zest and lemon juice. Turn the mixer to medium speed and beat for 1-2 minutes until creamy. Spread the frosting on top of the cake!

*Store in airtight container for up to 3 days

Prep Time: 20 mins.

Bake Time: 50 mins. + cooling

Servings: 10
