Sometimes we have stuff in our hands that we need to give away. Blessings cannot come if our hands are wrapped around all that we think is ours. We must let go of all we fear to lose. We must open our hands and give freely of our resources to the work of the kingdom of God.

We have been collecting cans and bottles and so far, we have returned 9000 cans for a total of \$500. These funds are going directly to our commitment to the Southern Sudan Health Project. We have pledged to support two workers for a total of \$3000 this year. PLEASE bring in your cans and bottles and see if we can't reach this goal by the end of the year. 

# **Cinnamon Roll Pancakes**

## INGREDIENTS

#### **For Pancakes**

- 1 1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup milk (may need to add a little more if batter is too thick)
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- 1 large egg, beaten
- OR use pancake batter from a mix (we like Bisquick)

#### **Cinnamon Filling**

- 1/3 cup butter, melted
- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon

#### **Cream Cheese Glaze**

- 4 tablespoon butter
- 2 ounces cream cheese
- 1 1/4 cups powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

## DIRECTIONS

- **1. Prepare Cinnamon Filling First:** In a medium bowl, mix butter, brown sugar and cinnamon. Scoop the filling into a small zip baggie and set aside. (Set this aside and let it rest for 10 to 15 minutes, you want it slightly thick.)
- **2. Prepare Pancake Batter:** In a medium bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder and salt. Whisk in milk, oil and egg until batter is moistened. (A few small lumps are fine.)
- **3. OR** if using boxed mix, prepare according to package directions.
- **4. Prepare Cream Cheese Glaze:** In a medium glass or microwave-safe bowl, heat the butter and cream cheese until melted. Whisk together until smooth, then whisk in powdered sugar and vanilla. Set aside.
- **5.** Heat a large skillet or griddle over low heat. Spray with non-stick cooking spray. Pour about 1/2 cup of pancake batter onto the skillet.
- Snip the corner of your cinnamon filled baggie and squeeze a spiral of the filling onto the top of the pancake
- When bubbles begin to appear on the surface, flip carefully with a spatula and cook until lightly browned on the underside, 1 to 2 minutes more. Transfer pancake to a baking sheet and keep warm in the oven while you make the rest of the pancakes.
- **6.** When ready to serve, spoon warmed cream cheese glaze on top of each pancake. Enjoy!

Prep Time: 30 mins.
Cook Time: 4 mins.
Total Time: 34 mins.
Makes: About 8 Pancakes
