



Strawberry Snacking Cake

INGREDIENTS


- 8 oz. strawberries, hulled, thinly sliced lengthwise
- 1 cup plus 3 tablespoons sugar, divided, plus more for pan Kosher salt
- 3/4 cup extra-virgin olive oil, plus more for pan
- ◆ 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup fine-grind cornmeal
- ◆ 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 3 large eggs
- ◆ 2 large egg yolks
- 1/2 cup plus 2 tablespoons sour cream
- 3 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup strawberry jam
- Finely grated zest of 2 lemons

DIRECTIONS

- **1.** Preheat oven to 350. Gently toss strawberries, 1 tablespoon sugar, and a pinch of salt in a medium bowl. Let sit, stirring occasionally, until ready to use.
- **2.** Grease a 13x9" pan with oil. Line with parchment paper, leaving an overhang on 2 long sides. Grease parchment with oil. Generously sprinkle pan and parchment with sugar, tilting to coat pan in an even layer; tap out excess.
- **3.** Whisk flour, cornmeal, baking powder, baking soda, 1 cup sugar, 1 tablespoon salt in a medium bowl. Whisk eggs, egg yolks, sour cream, lemon zest, lemon juice, and vanilla in a large bowl until well combined. Add dry ingredients to sour cream mixture and whish gently to combine. Using a spatula, gradually fold in 3/4 cup oil until batter is smooth and homogenous with all of the oil incorporated.
- **4.** Scrape batter into prepared pan and spread evenly. Using a small spoon, dollop jam onto surface. Using a butter knife or small offset spatula, gently swirl jam into batter. Arrange reserved strawberries on top of batter in even rows, touching at widest points. Sprinkle all over with remaining 2 tablespoons sugar.
- **5.** Bake cake until risen and deeply bronzed with no damp spots in the middle and a tester inserted into the center comes out clean, 40-45 minutes.
- **6. Do Ahead:** Cake can be made 4 days ahead. Cover with foil and store at room temperature.


