- 3 ripe pears, sliced thin into bite-sized pieces
- 3 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon corn starch
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 teaspoons cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt

#### For the Topping:

- 1/2 cup old fashioned oats
- 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/4 cup chopped pecans

1/3 cup unsalted butter, melted

#### For Serving:

 Vanilla ice cream, for serving, optional

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Coat an 8inch square baking dish with cooking spray.


2. In a large bowl toss all of the filling ingredients together until combined. Transfer to the baking dish.

3. In a medium bowl, stir all the topping ingredients together until combined.

**4.** Evenly sprinkle the topping over the pears.

5. Place in the oven and bake for 20-25 minutes until the pears are tender and the crust is golden.
