These are some of the questions that I have had over the years are as follows:

#### BIBLE STUDY



This past Fall I preached through the book of Habakkuk. From that preaching experience, I have developed a six-session study to go deeper into Habakkuk's message of complaining and God's response. We will explore themes of suffering and God's grace in those moments of suffering and explore the deeper concepts of praying through tough times.

#### **Chocolate Chip Cranberry Bread**

#### INGREDIENTS

#### **Ingredients**

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 large egg, room temperature
- 3/4 cup, 2% milk
- 6 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1 cup fresh or frozen cranberries, halved
- 1 cup miniature semisweet chocolate chips

#### Streusel

- 1/3 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 1/8 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 2 tablespoons cold butter
- 3/4 cup confectioners' sugar
- 2 to 3 tablespoons whole milk

#### DIRECTIONS

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Preheat the oven to 325 degrees.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine the flour, sugar, baking powder and salt. Whisk the egg, milk and butter; stir into dry ingredients just until moistened.
- 3. Fold in the cranberries and chocolate chips. Transfer to prepared pan.
- 4. In a small bowl, combine the brown sugar, flour and cinnamon; put in butter until crumbly. Sprinkle over batter.
- 5. Bake for 60-65 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean.
- 6. Cool for 10 minutes; loosen sides of bread from pan. Cool completely before removing from pan.

For the Glaze: Mix confectioners' sugar and 2 tablespoons milk until smooth; if needed, add additional 1 tablespoon milk to reach desired consistency. Drizzle glaze over top of bread; allow to sit 10 -15 minutes before slicing.

Prep Time: 20 mins. / Bake Time: 1 hr. + cooling

Makes: 1 loaf (16 slices)







#### Financial Report for 2022

I wanted to let everyone know how Faith Journey is doing financially, especially in light of how we have seen organizations and businesses around us adjust to a post-COVID world. It gives me great pleasure to report that congregational support has been consistent in 2022 and 2021 at just under \$120,000 annually. Other income such as interest, building use and fundraisers have varied a little – some up and some down – but overall have been similar for 2022 and 2021.

For missions in 2022, we have contributed \$1,810 to Upper New York Conference items such as Human Relations, Shared Ministry, UMCOR, etc. An additional \$660 has gone to local projects and \$1712.40 has been contributed to Southern Sudan Health Project. These contributions are a little lower than 2021, most notably donations to SSHP which are only about half of what was given in 2021.

Now for the bad news!! Even with the help of a little more than \$20,000 given from C & B 2.0, Chicken Bar-B-Q and Memorial Funds, we were not able to meet all of our UNYC expenses. These expenses cover our Pastor's health and retirement benefits as well as other conference expenses. Unfortunately, expenses rise each year unlike income that remains about the same.

The proceeds from the sale of the Morgan Road parsonage at the end of December will allow us to pay off the church mortgage early. This will reduce expenses \$1,479 per month. (Calculated on \$1,729 monthly mortgage, less \$500 monthly parsonage rental, increased by \$250 theater group rental.) This means for the remainder of 2023 we will realize a savings of \$16,269 in mortgage expenses and the elimination of this debt for future years.

With the continued support of the congregation and our other fundraisers, this year may be the closest to a balanced budget that we have seen in 15 years! I hope I haven't jinxed the mechanical world in the building by sharing my optimism, but I feel we have the opportunity to shift our focus more to God's work and less on paying the bills. Our church, as a whole, has accomplished so much in the face of financial hardships – just imagine what can be done with an easing of that burden!

Again, thank you all for your continued support and join me in getting excited for the future of Faith Journey!!
