Confirmed at St. James United Methodist Church, Niagara Falls, NY, and began my ministry career at the former Camp Findley, Findley Lake, NY.



It would be a United Methodist pastor who led me to the Lord when I was ten years at a summer camp session at Camp Asbury, Perry, NY. That same pastor would lead me back to the Lord after I graduated from college. The United Methodist Church would be where I found my place in ministry as I started serving as a pastor in 2002.

The United Methodist Church has been my greatest blessing and salvation. On March 4<sup>th,</sup> I will be interviewed by the Upper New York Annual Conference Board of Ordained Ministry to be commissioned as a provisional Elder in the United Methodist Church. For me, this has been a lifelong process that spans 24 years of ministry. I would be lying to you if I told you that I was not anxious about this interview. With that being said, I would like to ask for your prayers for the week of March 2-5<sup>th</sup>.

For a calmness of mind, body, and spirit.

For grace in dealing with tough questions of theology, polity, and faith.

And above all that, I speak the truth of the gospel of Jesus Christ in all my responses.

You are my church family, and I know you have the best in mind for me as your pastor. I, at times, convince myself that I am not enough, but in my heart, I know I am.

For me, this ordination process is not about getting to wear a stole or being able to do Communion and Baptisms outside of Faith Journey United Methodist Church. It is about a confirmation of a call to ordained ministry within the church as an Elder.

In the event that I am not commissioned this year, I will continue to serve under my Local Pastor's License.

My only thought is of the glory of God, which can be shown through my testimony of how God has worked in my life through the United Methodist Church. I will close with this passage from Philippians 2:12-18. This is the scripture I am focusing on for the upcoming interviews.

"Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, <sup>13</sup> for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

Do all things without grumbling or disputing, that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor in vain. Even if I am to be poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrificial offering of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with you all. Likewise, you also should be glad and rejoice with me."



# INGREDIENTS

# Cake:

- 1 1/2 sticks (12 tablespoons) unsalted butter, at room temperature, plus more for greasing the baking dish
- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 1/2 cups packed light brown sugar
- 2/3 cup smooth peanut butter
- 4 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- 3/4 teaspoon fine salt
- 3/4 cup milk
- 3/4 cup raspberry, strawberry or grape jelly

# **Topping:**

- 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 2/3 cup packed light brown sugar
- 2/3 cup honey-roasted peanuts, roughly chopped
- 1/4 teaspoon fine salt
- 4 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened
- Confectioners' sugar, for dusting


# DIRECTIONS

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Position an oven rack in the center of the oven, and preheat to 350 degrees. Butter a 9-by-13-inch baking dish.
- 2. **For the cake:** Whisk the flour, baking powder, salt and baking soda together in a large bowl.
- 3. Beat the brown sugar, butter and peanut butter in another large bowl with an electric mixer on medium-high speed until the mixture is light and creamy, about 5 minutes. Scrape down the side of the bowl as needed. Add the eggs, 1 at a time, beating well after each addition.
- 4. Continue beating until the mixture is light and creamy, about 2 minutes. Beat in the vanilla, reduce the mixer speed to medium-low, and add the flour mixture in 3 additions and the milk in 2 additions, beginning and ending with the flour. Beat until just combined.
- 5. Pour the batter into the prepared baking dish. Spoon dollops of the jelly all over the top, and swirl with the back of a spoon.
- 6. For the Topping: Mix together the flour, brown sugar, peanuts and salt in a small bowl to combine. Add the butter, and mix thoroughly with your fingers or a fork until it has been evenly distributed and incorporated into the flour mixture. Scatter the topping over the batter.
- 7. Bake for 50 to 60 minutes until the cake is golden brown and a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Let cool in the baking dish on a rack. Dust with confectioners' sugar, cut and serve.

**Total Time: 2 hrs. 40 mins** (includes cooling time) **Yield: 12 to 14 servings**
