Mango Crumb Bars

"These crumbly bars are filled with fresh mangos, then baked to perfection. These savory and yummy bars bursting with tropical flavor can be eaten as a fruity dessert, afternoon snack or delightful breakfast, they are delicious any time of the day!"

INGREDIENTS

- 2 1/2 cups ripe mangoes, small chunks (2-3 mangoes, depending on size)
- 3-5 tablespoon granulated sugar
- 1/2 tablespoon corn starch
- 2 cups flour
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 3/4 cup cold unsalted butter
- 2/3 cup brown sugar
- 1 large egg
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350F.

2. Cut mangoes into small chunks. In a bowl, combine mango chunks, sugar (use more if mango is not ripened) and corn starch. Mix well and set aside.

3. In a large mixing bowl, combine flour, baking powder and salt.4. Cut cold (important: make sure it is cold!) unsalted butter into chunks and add to flour mixture.

5. If using a food processor, pulse until small crumbs are formed. If using a pastry cutter, cut butter into flour mixture until small crumbs are formed.

6. Mix together wet ingredients—brown sugar, egg, and vanilla extract. Then add wet ingredients into buttery dry mixture and mix well, mixture should be slightly crumbly.

7. Bring 2/3 of crumbly mixture to the bottom of a 8" x 8" baking pan lined with parchment paper. Press mixture onto pan to form a layer of crumb pastry.

8. Add mango mixture, and spread it out evenly.

9. Then sprinkle the top with the rest of the crumbles.

10. Bake in the oven for 35-40 minutes.

11. Remove from oven and let it cool for 5-10 minutes. Then lift parchment paper and bring pastry out from the pan. Let it cool for another 15-20 minutes.

12. Cut into 9 square bars. Serve and enjoy!

Quick Tip for Mango Crumb Bars:

- Sour, under-ripe mangoes don't work as well in this recipe—so if your mango isn't super sweet, you would want to add more granulated sugar to the mango mixture to sweeten it.
