We wanted to thank you personally and share some exciting and impactful changes happening within our Life House program.

Over the past year, we have seen a significant increase in the need for our Restore program, which provides essential support to vulnerable women experiencing homelessness and the entrapment of sex trafficking. In response to this growing demand, we have made the strategic decision to restructure Life House. As part of this restructuring, we will be phasing out our residential program and integrating our services in collaboration with IMFK's Outreach program.



Have a very Merry Christmas - looking forward to spending a wonderful 2025 together.







Chocolate Caramel Thumbprint Cookies

"If you want a thick, chewy cookie that's loaded with chocolate flavor and smooth caramel, these caramel thumbprint cookies are perfect. With chopped pecans and a chocolate drizzle, these cookies will be the star of any party or potluck."

INGREDIENTS

- 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 2/3 cup sugar
- 1 large egg, separated, room temperature
- 2 tablespoon 2% milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup baking cocoa
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup finely chopped pecans

Filling for Cookies

- 12 to 14 caramels
- 3 tablespoons heavy whipping cream
- 1/2 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 teaspoon shortening

DIRECTIONS

- **1.** In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in egg yolk, milk and vanilla.
- **2.** In another bowl, whisk flour, cocoa and salt; gradually beat into creamed mixture. Refrigerate, covered, for 1 hour or until easy to handle.
- **3.** Preheat oven to 350. Shape dough into 1-in. balls. In a shallow bowl, beat egg white. Place pecans in a separate shallow bowl. Dip balls in egg white, then in pecans, patting to help pecans adhere.
- **4.** Place dough 2 in. apart on greased baking sheets. Press a deep indentation in a center of each with the end of a wooden spoon handle. Bake 10-12 minutes or until set. Remove from pans to wire racks to cool completely.
- **5.** In a large heavy saucepan, melt caramels with cream over low heat; stir until smooth. Fill each cookie with 1/2 teaspoon caramel mixture. In a microwave, melt chocolate chips and shortening; stir until smooth. Drizzle over cookies; let stand until set. Store in airtight container for freshness.

Cookie Tips, Variations and Substitutions:

- * There are a few substitutes for the heavy whipping cream: melted butter, evaporated milk, full-fat coconut milk or half and half are good since this recipe doesn't require you to actually whip the whipping cream—you can also combine half-and-half and melted butter in a 7:1 ratio (seven parts half -and-half to one part melted butter).
- * Try different types of nuts instead of pecans. Walnuts, almonds and hazelnuts are all nice options.
- * If you want a change from chocolate and caramel, you can use white chocolate from the drizzle and maraschino cherries for the filling.
- * You should be able to make these cookies gluten-free by using gluten-free flour, though the texture may change a little depending on the mix you use.

Prep Time: 25 mins. + chilling

Bake Time: 10 mins. Each batch + cooling

Yields about 2-1/2 dozen cookies
